FBI Director Mueller Visits Paris

The Director of the U.S. Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Robert S. Mueller III, visited Paris this week as part of his ongoing trip through Europe.

During his visit, Mr. Mueller met with the head of the National Police, Frédéric Péchenard, and other law enforcement and intelligence community counterparts. The purpose of the visit was to discuss ways to continue and to strengthen aggressive cooperative efforts on counterterrorism matters as well as cybercrime and transnational organized criminal matters. Mr. Mueller also met with his counterparts in law enforcement and intelligence agencies to confer on issues of mutual concern and to discuss ways to further enhance bilateral relations.

Noting that this was his fourth visit to Paris, Mr. Mueller praised the strong efforts of the French government in the global fight against terrorism and other serious crimes.
