

Free Paris Domestic Violence Awareness Month Seminar Seeking Participants

President Obama has proclaimed the month of October National Domestic Violence Awareness Month. The Americans Overseas Domestic Violence Crisis Center (AODVC), in collaboration with the Ending Violence Against Women & Children Committee of the Federation of American Women Clubs Overseas (FAWCO), will offer a FREE one-day program Friday, October 30th in Paris.

The goal of this program is twofold: first, to educate all participants on issues American victims of domestic violence face overseas and the services that the AODVC provides to American domestic violence victims living in foreign countries, and, second, to train ambassadors to raise awareness of domestic violence issues and AODVC in their host countries by speaking to local women's organizations, women's shelters, international schools and other groups.

The Program will include a general information presentation in the morning and a volunteer outreach ambassador training session in the afternoon. Sessions and materials will be free of charge. Lunch will be available and participants can indicate if they are staying for lunch on the registration form. Cash for lunch needs to be brought the day of the session.
